To receive the vaccine you must bring a Photo ID.

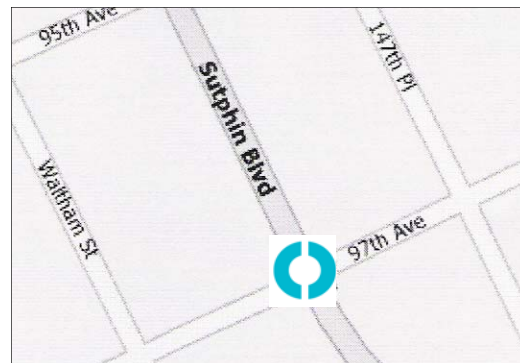
Should I get the vaccine?

The H1N1 vaccine is being recommended for:

- Pregnant women
- People 6 months to 24 years old
- People 25 to 64 with chronic conditions
(Asthma, diabetes, heart, kidney, neurologic and immune system disorders)
- People who live with or care for children less than 6 months old
- Healthcare workers and emergency medical responders

Where can I find the center?

By Subway: "E" train to Sutphin Blvd
(riding in the middle car will put you right in front of escalator to exit upstairs), walk south three blocks to 97th Avenue.
