

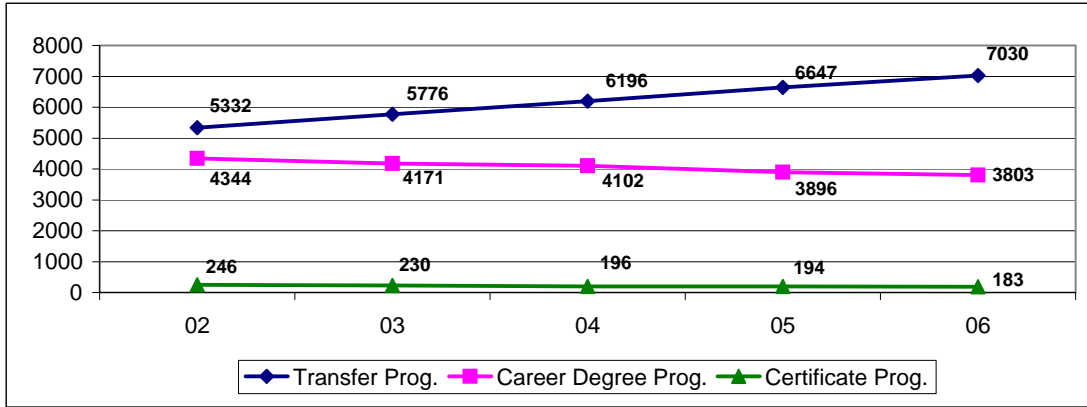

### Comparison of Enrollment by Program F'02-F'06



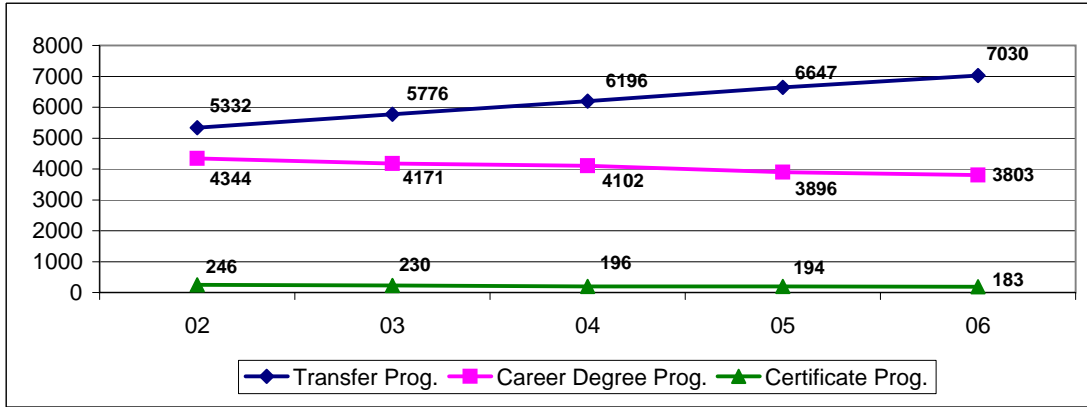

Enrollment in "Transfer Programs" has grown 31.85% since Fall 2002; while "Career Degree Programs" has declined 12.45% in the same period.

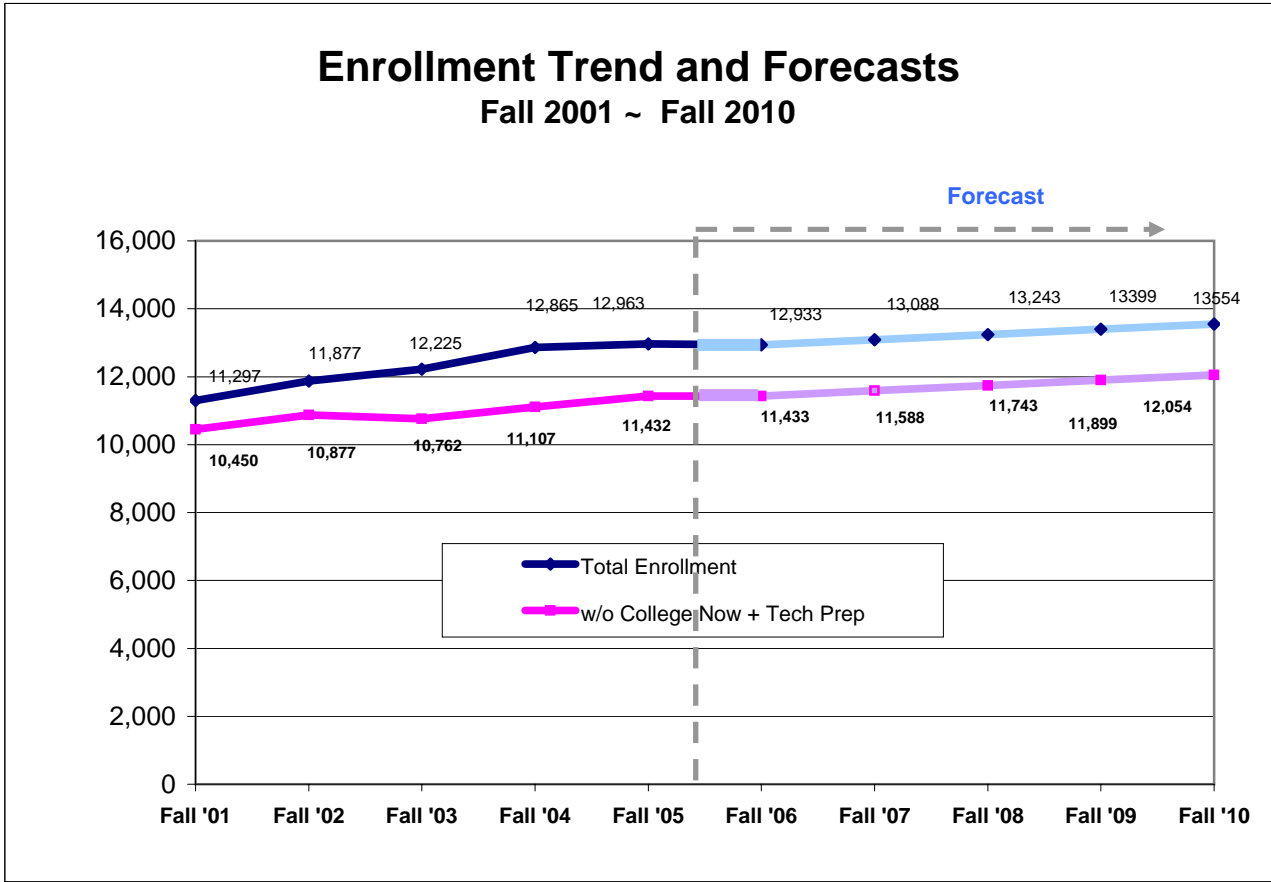

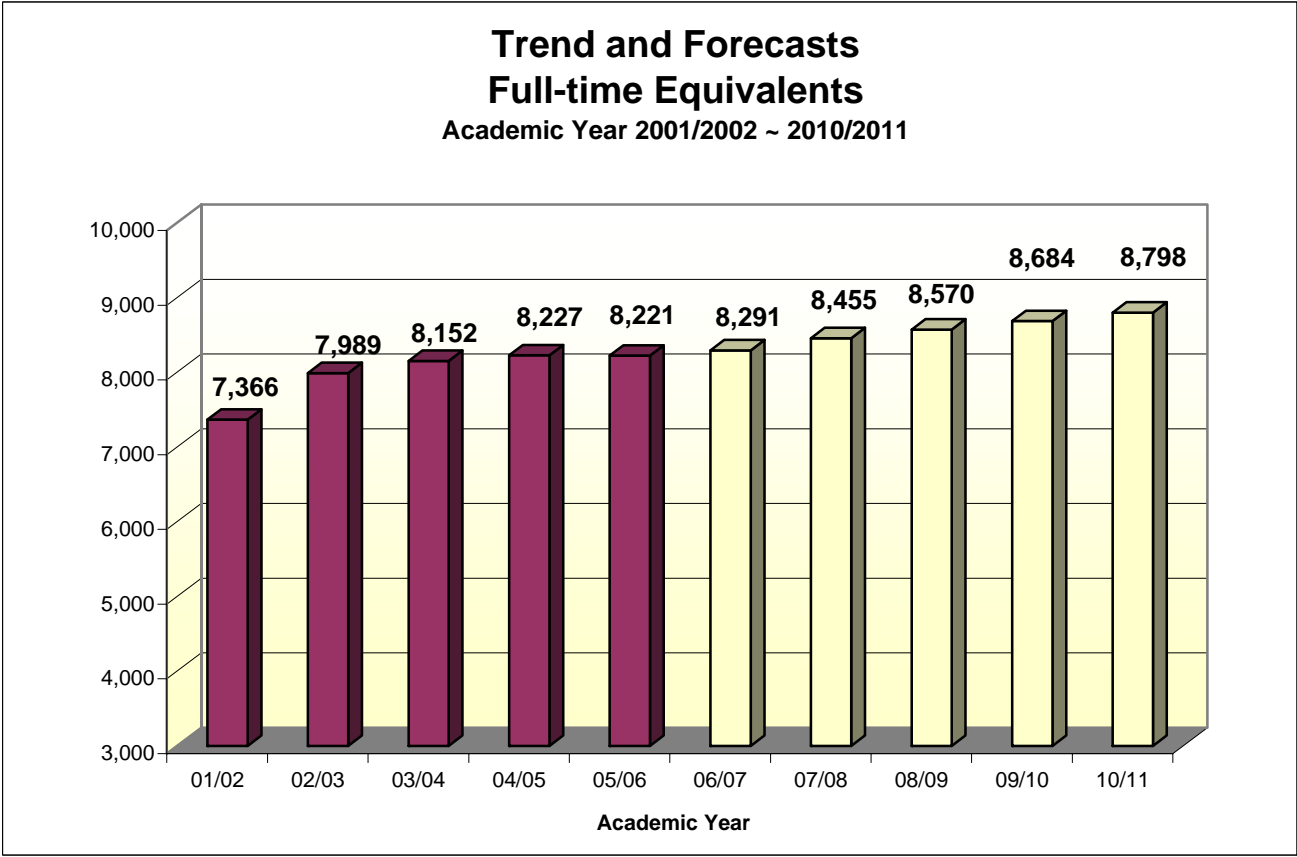
The top chart shows full and part-time enrollment for all students including the high school students who are part of College Now and Tech Prep programs and enrolled part-time at QCC. When these high school students are excluded, enrollment of full time matriculated students has remained constant since Fall '00, range from 55 ~ 56.

Overall Fall enrollment has increased 14.7% between Fall '01 and Fall '05 (blue line). This figure includes high school students who participate in College-level courses through the CUNY College Now program and Tech Prep. When these high school students are subtracted from the figures (red line) enrollment is relatively constant from Fall '01 to Fall '05.

Recent changes in the College Now Program will limit the growth of the program in the future. The College Now Program has been stimulating the overall growth in enrollment at Queensborough. Trends in Queens County High School enrollments indicate nearly 4,400 fewer students enrolled in Queens Public High School by Fall 2008 as compared to Fall 2003. This will also have an impact on future Queensborough enrollment.

Trend and forecasts were completed for the Full-time Equivalents (FTEs) for the academic years 2001/2002 through 2010/2011. The chart above indicates a slow and modest rise over the next five academic years. Recent changes in the College Now Program will limit the growth of the program in the future. The College Now Program has been stimulating overall enrollment growth and FTE production at Queensborough.
