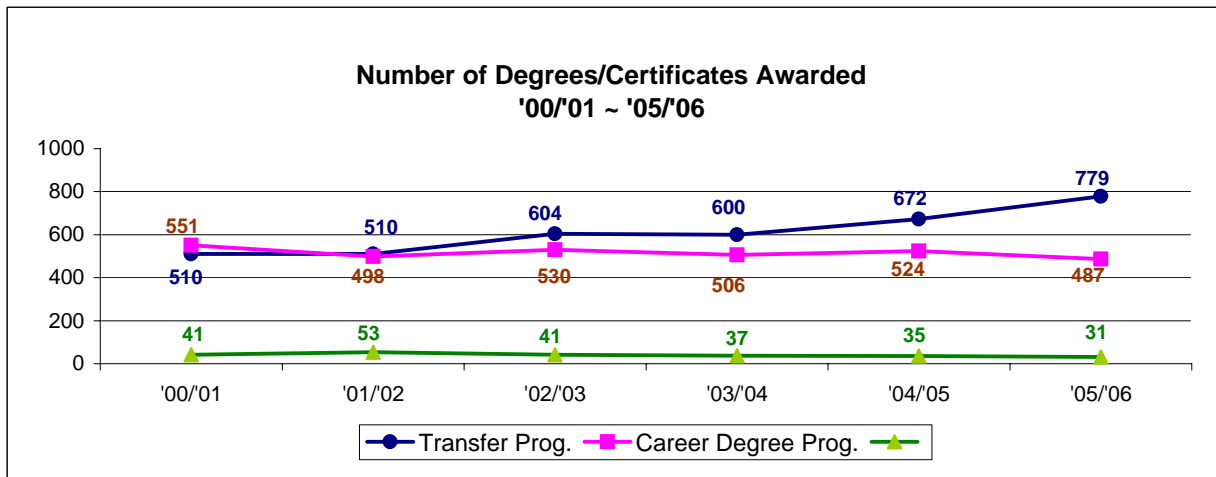

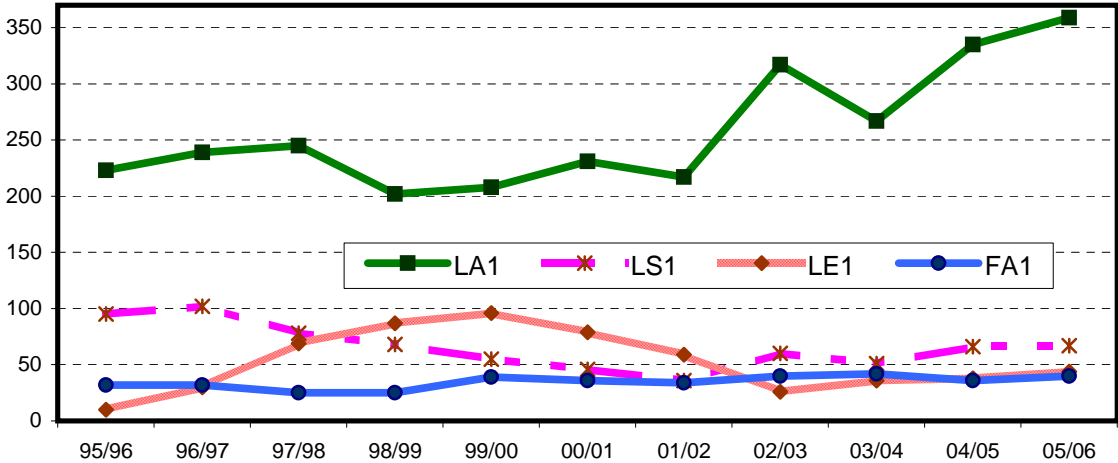

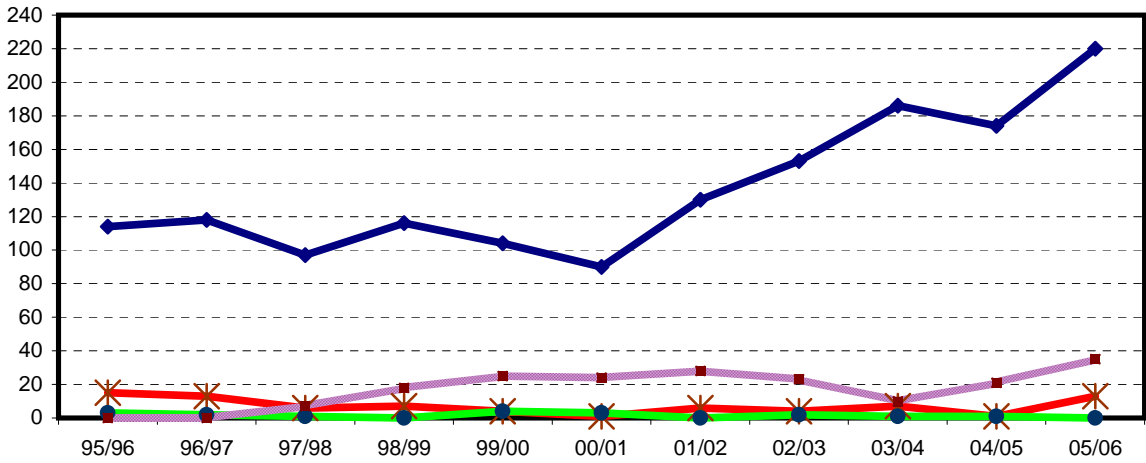

Number of Transfer Degrees Awarded Liberal Arts/Fine Arts 95/96 - 05/06

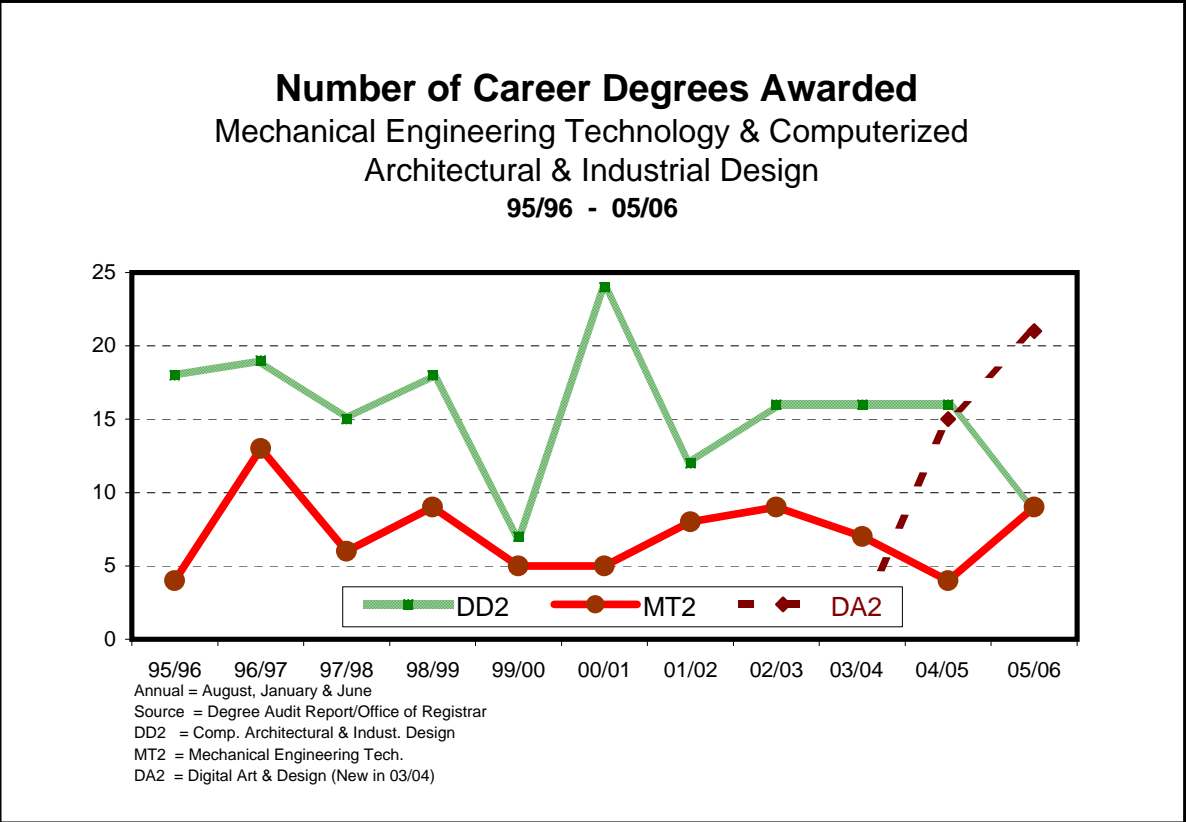
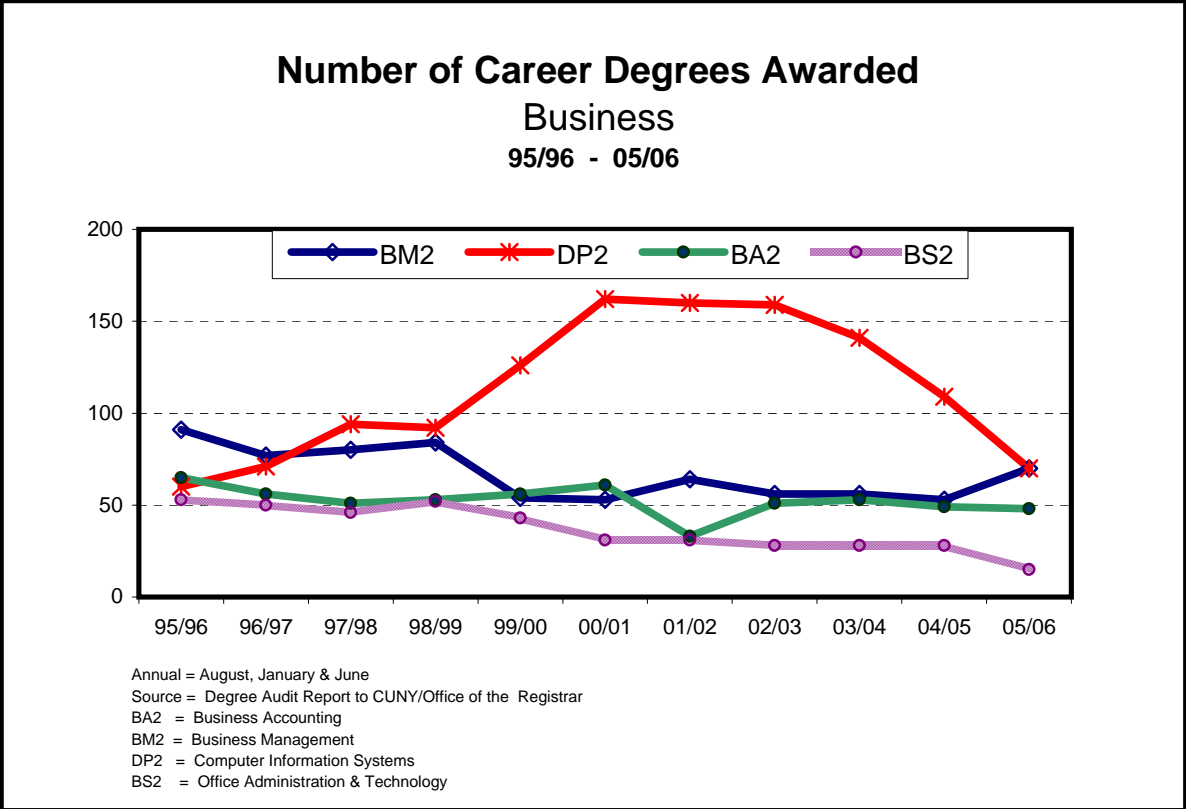

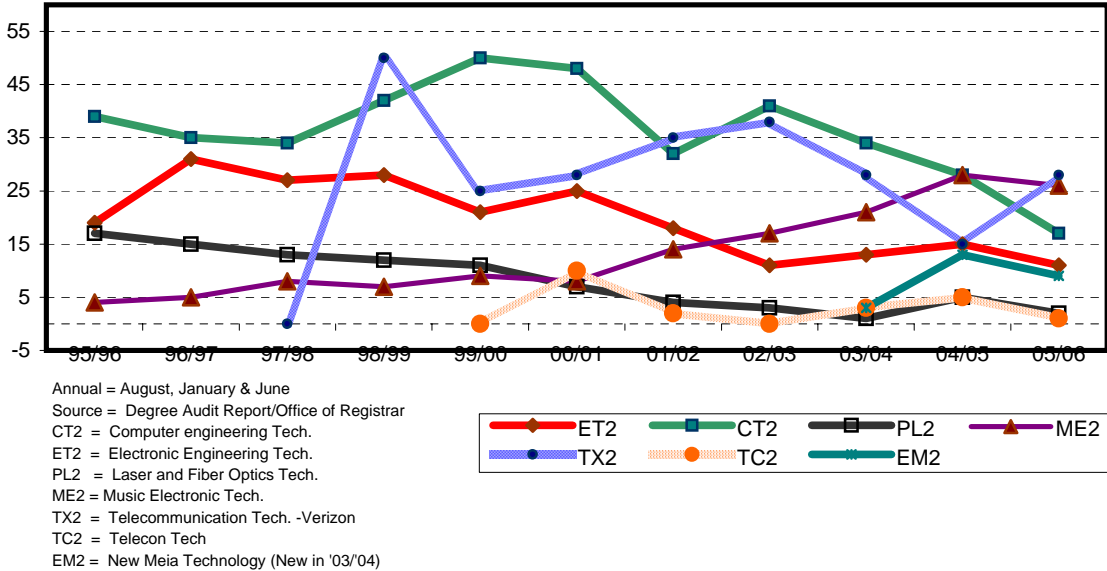
Number of Transfer Degrees Awarded Science/Business 95/96 - 05/06



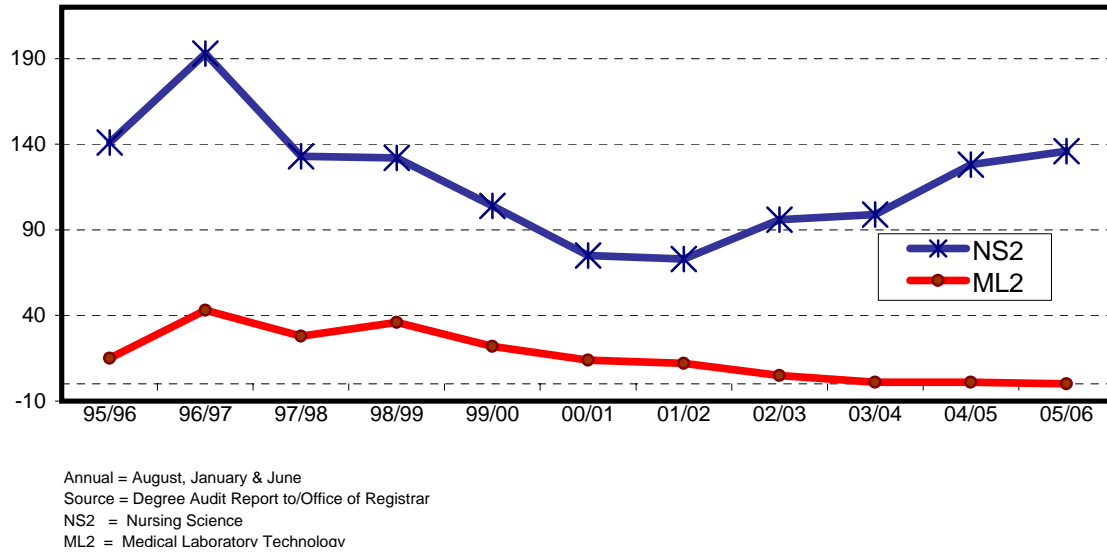

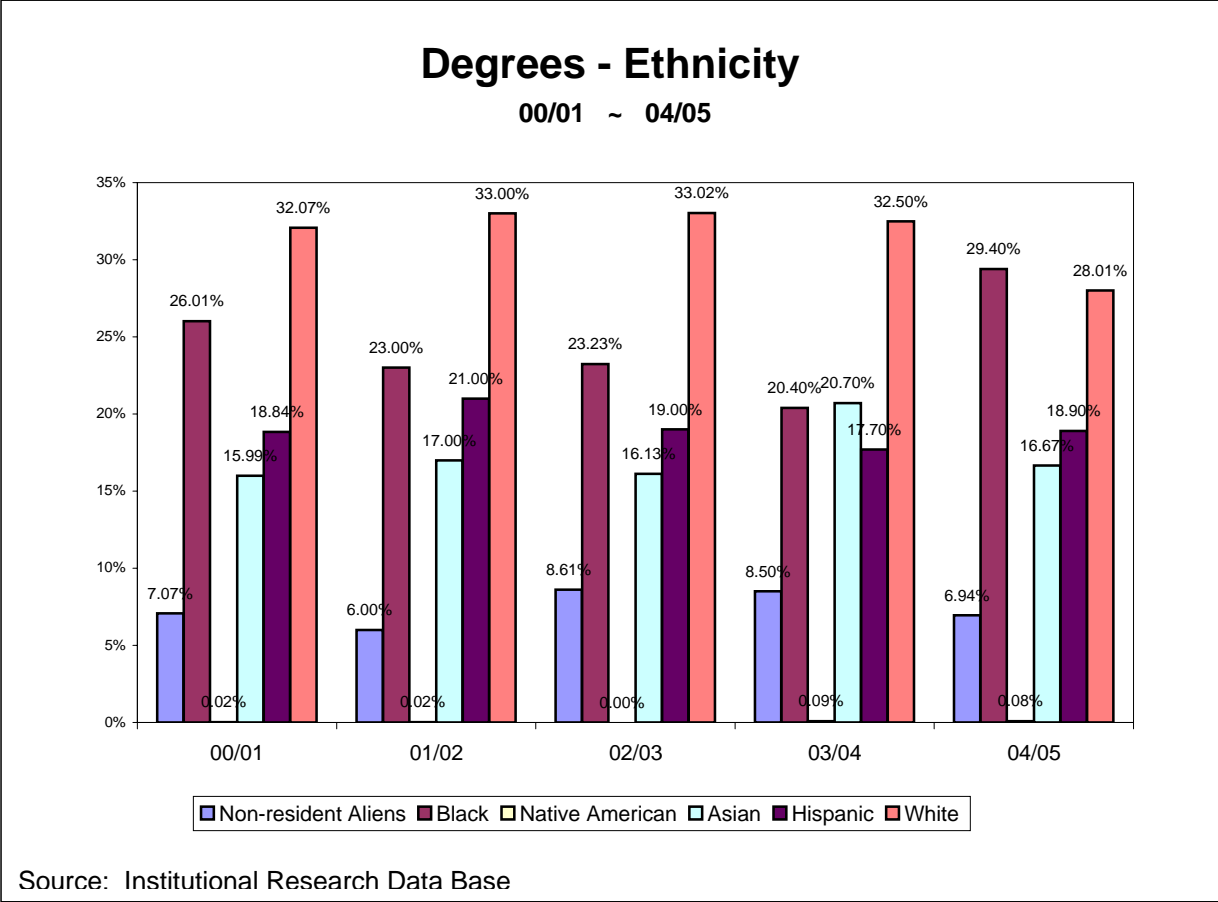


Number of Career Degrees Awarded Technology 95/96 - 05/06

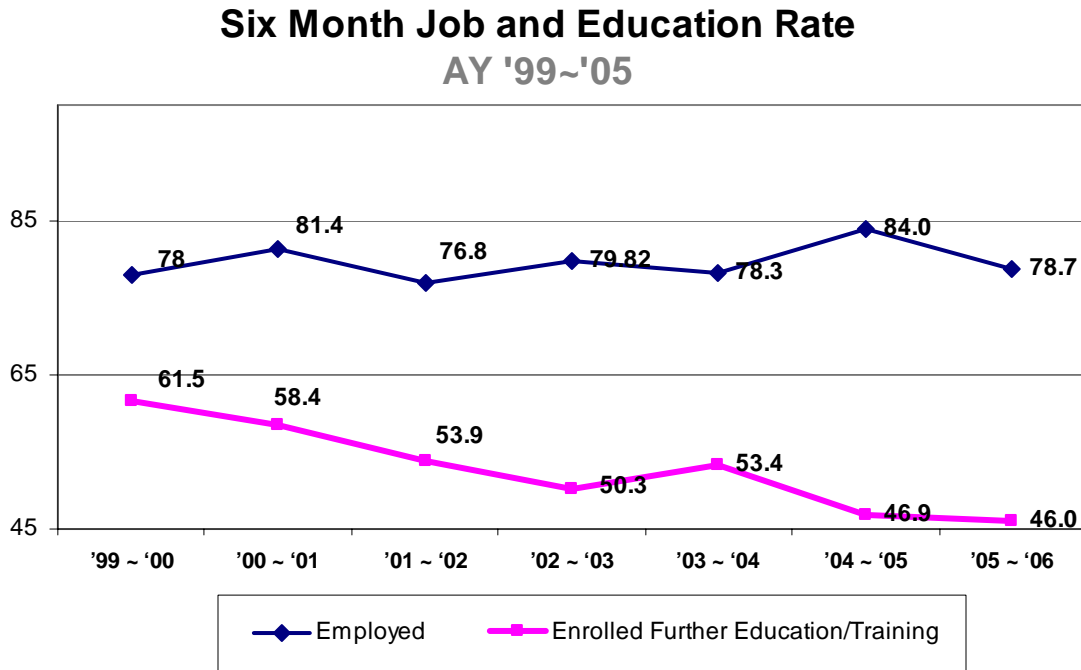
