2. Students who place above MA-119 will use MA-336 to satisfy Required Core 1 B and take an additional 3 credits of free electives.
3. Students may count PSYC-101 toward Flexible Core 2 E and take an additional 3 credits of free electives (an additional major elective course is recommended).
4. Students must complete one course from each of the Flexible Core categories ( $2 \mathrm{~A}, 2 \mathrm{~B}, 2 \mathrm{C}, 2 \mathrm{D}$, and 2 E ) and one additional course from any one of the categories.
5. Students who take a STEM Variant course in 1 C do not have to take an additional laboratory course
6. Major Electives: students must take two courses from the table below, at least one of which must be from the PSYC-200 series.

All students must complete two (2) WI designated classes to fulfill degree requirements.
