

# **Degree Pathway**

# A.S. in Theatre (Acting and Technical Theatre Concentrations<sup>1</sup>) – Catalog Year 2023-24

The number of credits you earn each year will determine when you graduate. To graduate within 2 years, you are strongly encouraged to enroll in at least 30 credits toward your degree during the calendar year, including fall and spring semesters and winter and summer sessions. This Degree Pathway is designed for students who place into developmental English and math. An additional pathway is available for students who place into ENGL-101 and MA-321. Please see the degree website, your college advisor, or theatre faculty mentor for more information.

THE FIRST YEAR OF COURSES: In order to support correct placement and timely graduation, for the first two semesters (30 credits), theatre majors, working with a college advisor and theatre faculty mentor, are assigned a schedule of courses with a cohort of their peers. The schedule is designed to introduce students to the study of Theatre in higher education and includes foundational courses required for the Liberal Arts General Education A.S. Degree.

Theatre majors should not register for evening courses, courses that begin or end after 4:30pm (Tuesday/Thursday) or 5:00pm (Monday/Wednesday/Friday), so that they are available participate in productions, co-, and extra-, curricular department activities. Theatre majors should always meet with their assigned theatre faculty mentor prior to advisement and registering for courses.

Courses in **Bold Text** are prerequisites for later courses and should be taken where indicated in the sequence.

#### Notes:

- 1. Students choose a concentration in either Acting or Technical Theatre and complete 3 credits from the following: Acting students should take TH-221, Acting II, and Technical Theatre students should take TH-231, Stagecraft II. Students then, in consultation with their theatre faculty mentor, select 13 additional credits to complement their concentration from the list of Theatre Major Electives below.
- 2. Prerequisites for a course must be passed before taking the course. Corequisites must be passed before taking the course or taken in the same term as the course.
- 3. Students are required to take certain courses in some areas of the Common Core that fulfill both general education and major requirements. If students do not take the required courses in the Common Core, they will have to take additional credits to complete their degree requirements.
- 4. Students must complete one course each from Flexible Core categories 2A, 2D, and 2E and one additional course from any one of the categories (2A, 2B, 2C, 2D, and 2E). SP-211 will satisfy Flexible Core Area 2B and TH-111 will satisfy Flexible Core Area 2C.
- 5. This course is not required for students who take a 4-credit STEM variant course in Required Core 1C.

All students must successfully complete two Writing Intensive classes (designated "WI") to fulfill degree requirements.
