

## Recommended Course Sequence

The number of credits you take each year will determine when you graduate. To graduate on time, you are strongly encouraged to enroll in at least 30 credits toward your degree during the calendar year, including fall and spring semesters and winter and summer sessions.

### A.S. Degree in Theatre - Acting Concentration- Catalog Year 2017-18

**Theatre Majors should not register for evening courses**, courses that begin or end after 6:00pm, so as to participate in productions, co-, and extra-, curricular department activities; **should not register for TH-120 (Non-Majors Acting Course)**, if TH-121 (Majors Acting Course) is not available; **who wish to be cast in department productions**, should not register for courses on Tuesdays/Thursdays 4:10pm-6:40pm. Students cast in productions will be registered for Theatre Elective TH-122 or TH-222 Actor's Workshop I & II (3 cr.); **should always meet with their assigned Theatre Faculty Mentor**, prior to registering for courses.
