# **Recommended Course Sequence**

### Dual/Joint A.A.S. Degree in Nursing (QCC) leading to the B.S. in Nursing (Hunter Bellevue) Catalog Year 2017-18

Clinical students in NU-101 may apply for the Dual/joint Degree Program in Nursing with Hunter-Bellevue School of Nursing. Admission to the program is extremely competitive and will be based on the student's GPA and overall academic work. A student must receive a faculty recommendation indicating a strong clinical performance in NU-101. In addition to the courses required for their A.A.S. degree, students will be encouraged to complete additional liberal arts, science, and humanities courses that can be applied to the B.S. degree. Students will be guided in the selection of these courses by an advisor to maximize the courses that meet the general education, as well as the pluralism and diversity, graduation requirements for the Hunter-Bellevue School of Nursing.

In the suggested sequence below, students are encouraged to take courses at Hunter-Bellevue School of Nursing as they are completing their curriculum at Queensborough. Students will also complete credits in excess of Queensborough's degree requirements that will automatically transfer to Hunter to expedite completion of the baccalaureate program.
