- **Pedagogical Research**
 - Is this pedagogical research? (If Yes, then continue)
- **Pedagogical Merit**
 - Is the proposed work based on previous pedagogical research or established theories?
 - Does the project team have the background knowledge to carry out the work?
- **Innovation and potential usefulness of the results**
 - How unique is the proposed project?
 - Will the project contribute to the discipline and/or be applicable on a larger scale at QCC?
- **Clear articulation of a research question/methodology and research design**
 - Is there a clear hypothesis that is being tested?
 - Is the experiment well thought out?
 - Are there plans for the hypothesis to be tested in a systematic way?
- **Clear and achievable research plan**
 - Does the project have adequate resources to carry out the proposed work?
 - Is the budget request reasonable?
 - Is the timeline reasonable?
