## **Dual/Joint Application**

Queensborough Community College Nursing program has a Dual/Joint Program with Hunter Bellevue School of Nursing, leading to a Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing.

This is an unique, competitive opportunity for NU101 students to apply for a dual joint degree with Hunter Bellevue School of Nursing. The maximum, eligible credits transferred to Hunter for an Associate's Degree is 77.5 and 90 credits for attendance at a senior college or previous Bachelor's Degree. Applicants meeting the criteria below should submit application to nursing office up to one week after the National League of Nursing (NLN) standardized exam.

## Criteria for selection of candidates for the dual enrollment are as follows:

- B or better in NU101
- Overall GPA > 3.0
- Time commitment
  - Working less than twenty hours weekly is recommended during QCC enrollment
  - o Required attendance at professional development workshops at Hunter approximately twice yearly.
  - o Complete additional courses: Statistics, Chemistry before nursing semester 201.
  - o Enroll in each semester consecutively at QCC and Hunter without leave of absence.
  - o Signature indicating your agreement to fulfill the time commitment.
- Clinical Faculty Recommendation by completing the attached rubric.
