Requirements for acceptance into TEACHER ACADEMY

- Completion of 12 credits of college courses with a GPA of 3.00
- Eligibility for or completion of English 101
- Completion of precalculus (MA-440 or equivalent) with a grade of B or better
- Personal essay
- A letter of recommendation from a math or science professor
- U.S. citizenship or permanent resident
