

# **Degree Pathway**

## A.S. in Theatre (Acting and Technical Theatre Concentrations<sup>1</sup>) – Catalog Year 2020-21

The number of credits you earn each year will determine when you graduate. To graduate within 2 years, you are strongly encouraged to enroll in at least 30 credits toward your degree during the calendar year, including fall and spring semesters and winter and summer sessions. This Degree Pathway is designed for students who place into developmental English and math. An additional pathway is available for students who place into ENGL-101 and MA-321. Please see the degree website, your college advisor, or theatre faculty mentor for more information.

THE FIRST YEAR OF COURSES: In order to support correct placement and timely graduation, for the first two semesters (30 credits), theatre majors, working with a college advisor and theatre faculty mentor, are assigned a schedule of courses with a cohort of their peers. The schedule is designed to introduce students to the study of Theatre in higher education and includes foundational courses required for the Liberal Arts General Education A.S. Degree.

Theatre majors should not register for evening courses, courses that begin or end after 4:30pm (Tuesday/Thursday) or 5:00pm (Monday/Wednesday/Friday), so that they are available participate in productions, co-, and extra-, curricular department activities. Theatre majors should always meet with their assigned theatre faculty mentor prior to advisement and registering for courses.

Courses in **Bold Text** are prerequisites for later courses and should be taken where indicated in the sequence.

#### Notes:

- 1. Acting students should take TH-221 and Technical Theatre students should take TH-231. Students should consult with their Theatre Faculty Mentor when choosing their major requirements and electives. Choice of those courses determines whether students will earn the Acting or Technical Theatre concentration.
- 2. Prerequisites for a course must be passed before taking the course. Corequisites must be passed before taking the course or taken in the same term as the course.
- 3. Students who have taken SP-211 in the Common Core (area 2B) are required to take an additional Theatre Major Elective course.
- 4. Students who have taken TH-111 in the Common Core (area 2C) are required to take an additional Theatre Major Elective course.
- 5. This course is not required for students who take a 4-credit STEM variant course in Required Core 1C.
- 6. Students must complete one course from each of the Flexible Core categories (2A, 2B, 2C, 2D, and 2E) and one additional course from any one of the categories.

All students must successfully complete two Writing Intensive classes (designated "WI") to fulfill degree requirements.
