The number of credits you take each year will determine when you graduate. To graduate on time, you are strongly encouraged to enroll in at least 30 credits toward your degree during the calendar year, including fall and spring semesters and winter and summer sessions. This Degree Pathway is designed for students who place into **ENGL-101 and MA-321**. An additional pathway is available for students who must complete developmental math or English. Notes:

- 1. Prerequisites for a course must be passed before taking the course. Corequisites must be passed before taking the course or taken in the same term as the course.
- 2. Art and Design Concentration students must take 22-24 credits of art courses, as prescribed by the table below. A minimum of 16 credits of ARTS courses is required.
- 3. Students who have taken SP-211 in the Common Core are recommended to take a Foreign Language course; or HIST-110, HIST-111, HIST-112; or a Social Sciences course.
- 4. Students must complete one course from each of the Flexible Core categories (2A, 2B, 2C, 2D, and 2E) and one additional course from any one of the categories. Students are recommended to select two courses from Area 2C.
- 5. This course is not required for students who take CH-106 or a 4-credit STEM variant course in Required Core 1C.

All students must complete two (2) WI designated classes to fulfill degree requirements.



Art and Design Concentration – Students select 22-24 credits, 6 credits in one category and 16-18 credits in a second category. **A minimum of 16 credits in ARTS courses is required.** Courses should be chosen in consultation with a departmental adviser.
