Notes:

- 1. Prerequisites for a course must be passed before taking the course. Corequisites must be passed before taking the course or taken in the same term as the course.
- 2. Musicianship Placement: MUS-111 (for students with minimal or no music background); placement into MUS-112, MUS-122, MUS-225, MUS-132 and MUS-231 is determined by an evaluation of musicianship skills; 3 credits each. MUS-122 is offered Spring Semester only. MUS-221 is offered Fall Semester only. Students wishing to take the Music Placement Test may schedule a time by contacting the Music department, Humanities Building, room 140; 718-631-6393
- 3. Students must complete one 100-level MUS course and two history or social science courses from Flexible Core 2A, 2B, 2D, or 2E.

All students must successfully complete two Writing Intensive classes (designated "WI") to fulfill degree requirements.
