Notes:

1. Prerequisites for a course must be passed before taking the course. Corequisites must be passed before taking the course or taken in the same term as the course.
2. If SP-211 is taken for Flexible Core 2B, take a HIST-100 course instead. If two history courses have been taken, one additional course from the International Studies Concentration is recommended.
3. Students must complete one course from each of the Flexible Core categories (2A, 2B, 2C, 2D, and 2E) and one additional course from any one of the categories.
4. This course is not required for students who take a 4-credit STEM variant course in Required Core 1C.
5. If HIST-110, HIST-111, or HIST-112 is taken for Flexible Core 2A, take a second HIST-100 course instead. If two history courses have been taken, one additional course from the International Studies Concentration is recommended.
