Notes:

1. Prerequisites for a course must be passed before taking the course. Corequisites must be passed before taking the course or taken in the same term as the course.
2. Two sequential courses in the same language are required. Please visit the [Department of Modern Languages and Cultures](#) for placement into the first course.
3. If SP-211 is taken for Flexible Core 2B, take a HIST-100 course instead. If two history courses have been taken, one additional course from the Spanish Language Concentration is recommended.
4. Students must complete one course from each of the Flexible Core categories (2A, 2B, 2C, 2D, and 2E) and one additional course from any one of the categories. Spanish Language students are recommended to take a 400-level LS course to fulfill the requirement for 2A (World Cultures and Global Issues).
5. If HIST-110, HIST-111, or HIST-112 is taken for Flexible Core 2A, take a second HIST-100 course instead. If two history courses have been taken, one additional course from the Spanish Language Concentration is recommended.
6. This course is not required for students who take a 4-credit STEM variant course in Required Core 1C.

Students must complete a minimum of 48 Liberal Arts and Sciences courses for this program. [Please see the catalog](#) for course subjects that fall into that category.

All students must complete two (2) WI designated classes to fulfill degree requirements.
