During the academic year 2007-2008 a total # of 200 deletion appeals were reviewed and 164 were approved which is 82%.

During the academic year 2008-2009 a total # of 275 deletion appeals were reviewed and 259 were approved which is 94.18%.

The heaviest work-load for the committee has always been at the "dismissal" meeting that takes place between semesters.

### I. Dismissals

Requests for Academic Dismissal and Probation are initiated through the Registrar's Office.

During the academic year 2007-2008 312 (27.29 %) of the 1143 dismissal appeals were approved. In the academic years 2008-2009, 305 (27. 40%) of the 1113 appeals were

approved. Those students whose appeals were approved remained on academic probation.

#### II. Other Issues

The Committee on Course & Standing has been working directly with Ms. Gina Capozzoli, also a committee member, to assist students who committee members recognize as needing special assistance. The retroactive withdrawals are being granted conditionally to some students who are identified as needing academic counseling. These students are directed to the Counseling Department.

CUNY first, the University's student system will soon be implemented. All the colleges in the CUNY system are being integrated into one system. All the colleges will be regulated by basically the same policies. The work of the Committee on Course & Standing will be impacted. Daily class attendance would no longer be required. Faculty attendance rosters have been one of the main criteria in the basis of Committee's decision.

Students who are receiving Pell Grants and are filing appeals with CCS must be reviewed on a priority basis. Federal fund regulations require that any students receiving a PELL award and requesting late withdrawals from their courses have a decision within 30 days of their request.

All appeals for Medical withdrawals must be first forwarded to Health Services for review. Once Health Services approve the medical withdrawal, they are forwarded to the Registrar's office for final processing.

The staff of the Registrar's Office; Ms. Ann Tullio, Ms Florence Farrat, Meera Chowdhry and June Greco have been a tremendous source of support and dedication in their efforts to provide the highest level of professional service to the Course and Standing Committee.

It has been the Chair's privilege to serve with the Course and Standing Committee. The members of this committee are a dedicated group of professionals. This committee has utilized their best judgment to follow committee guidelines to adjudicate compelling and at times, difficult decisions. It is inspiring to be a part of this dedicated and caring committee.

Professor Glenn Burdi is the presiding chair of the CCS for the year 2009-2010. Dr. Bryn Mader, Biology Department, Dr. Lisa Mertz, Heath Science, Department, Dr. Jannette Urciuoli, Counseling, and Dr. Jilani Warsi are the new members of the CCS for the year 2009-2010.
