Guest Prof. Kevin Kolack from the eLearning Committee discussed the "Fitness while studying" initiative. Another concern was dissemination of information once a routine way developed.

Committee Suggestions:

Chair Chang offered to follow up with Marketing to inquire about the College's app and if that would be a viable source for information.
