4. Anti-Bullying Statement

The publications committee received an email request from the academic senate steering committee on behalf of the subcommittee on Bullying (which falls under the Committee on Environment, Quality of Life, and Disability Matters) to investigate whether or not the faculty senate approved statement on Bullying, *Bullying in the QCC community*, has been incorporated into the Faculty Handbook or College Catalog.

The committee did not find the anti-bullying statement to be in either the online faculty handbook or the 2015-2016 college catalog. Raul A. reported that Noel Sangeeta of Faculty and Staff Relations was consulted and will inquire as to whether or not there are plans to incorporate this statement into the handbook or catalog.
