Summary of actions not covered by the above

However, due to low responses from organizations and a similar event by Career Service, the volunteer fair was canceled. The committee is looking to partner with the Career Services Department to coordinate for next year's volunteer fair. In addition, we continued to work closely with the SGA to ensure we could continue assisting them in furthering their agenda.

The committee is in the process of surveying students (Fall 2024) regarding the best way to facilitate communication about campus events. The committee decided to draft the survey in Fall 2023 and distribute it in Spring 2024. However, the survey was delayed because the Institutional Research Department conducted too many surveys during the

Spring 2024 semester. The Committee was advised that the survey will be done in Fall 2024. The committee is awaiting the data results to see how the committee can improve communication of the various activity events to the students.

- We will continue to liaise with the SGA to facilitate their platform and goals wherever appropriate.
