## **COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

February 21, 2007, in M-127 at 12:00 PM

Attending: Sharon Ellerton, Robert Kueper, Danny Mangra, Nam Jong Moh, Phyllis Pace, George Sherman, Jun Shin, George Thorsen and Craig Weber.

- 1. Minutes from the Dec.13, 2006 meeting were unanimously approved.
- 2. Chair Thorsen offered to write letters of recommendation for committee member service in writing articles for the CCR newsletter.
- 3. Thoughts and reactions to Fall newsletter
  - a. Some positive responses were noted
- 4. Vista issues
  - a. IT Director Sherman informed the committee that the CUNY EMall Symantec antivirus download incompatibility is being dealt with and Symantec 10.2/vista compatible should be available soon.
  - b. Director Sherman gave his reasons for not supporting a switch to Vista at this time. Newly ordered QCC computers should be Vista capable but set for XP, Service Pack 2.
    - i. Currently vista has high requirements for memory and space; requires one gigabyte of RAM to work optimally.
    - ii. Software may not be compatible or require upgrades
  - c. Vista makes computers more expensive since requires greater hardware requirements and compatible software
- 5. Director Sherman reported on MS office suite and other MS products
  - a. timeframe for free software under a new CUNY license is unknown.
  - b. Majority of faculty now have Office XP; recommends increasing to Office 2003, not to Office 2007, since:
    - i. requires high end hardware
    - ii. requires some training since it is visually different
  - c. will upgrade for faculty that will teach Office 2007 to students
  - d. Chair Thorsen commented that documents created in Office 2007 are \_\_\_\_\_.docX. These are not backwards compatible and will not open as a

- doc. Converter patch is available.
- 6. Electronic grading is operating this semester. Dir Sherman will investigate some questions raised by the committee as to:
  - a. input attendance for hybrid courses
  - b. whether a recorded absence can be changed
- 7. New Business
  - a. clickers
    - i. QCC is interested in 1 standardized type since various brands are not interchangeable
    - ii . Drs. Gerson and Birchfield are studying various brands of clickers and will write a report with recommendations.
