## Discussion:

The Committee met to review the late/retroactive withdrawals.
The Chair of the Committee Dr. Steven Dahlke had a discussion with the Admissions Committee regarding the appeals for re-admissions. The Admissions Committee recommends students appeal to the Committee on Course \& Standing for 'WU' grades to be change to 'W'. It was decided unanimously by the CCS members that the Admissions Committee recommended appeals would be considered by the CCS, positively.

It was decided in the previous meetings, that all students would be dismissed, below a 2.0 GPA. The students could then appeal to the Committee on Course \& Standing for a Continued Probation, if they have a GPA of 1.8 or above. Student with a lower than 1.8 GPA, could appeal for a continued probation if they have legitimate reasons for not being able to perform well in their academics, together with supporting documents.

The Committee would meet during the end of June to review the Continued Probation appeals.
