Discussion:

The Committee met to review the Retroactive withdrawal / Late Withdrawal appeals.

The Committee Members reviewed the retroactive appeals of the students and those who had genuine difficulties in not being able to withdraw in a timely manner and were supported with documents were approved.

The appeals for Late/Retroactive withdrawal concerning students who are having some mental health issues are being reviewed/recommended for approval by the Counseling Office. The standard basis of approval of medical related issues have been that students should appeal either the whole semester or none. It is the consideration that a student is not being selective. However, Prof. Capozzoli also representing the Counseling Office, brought before the Committee Members the reasoning of students who were only seeking withdrawal from few of their courses during the semester. In some situations, the professors are willing to work with students and in others students are able to handle certain courses that are not very taxing.
