Scal, Roland	Biology	Moved from ALTERNATES (Faculty-At-Large) to FACULTY-AT-LARGE: Assumes seat of Dr. Robert Becker, who is on leave. ¹	
¹ <i>Bylaws of the Academic Senate, ARTICLE I, Section 2: "... Vacant seats among the faculty members at large shall be filled by the Committee on Committees, using the top of the list from the most recent election. A seat shall be so filled until (1) the Senator elected thereto is qualified to resume the seat, or (2) the term expires."</i>			

Revisions to Standing Committees Personnel

- The following revisions have been made to the rosters of the Standing Committees of the Academic Senate:

Name	Department	Description of Revision	
Neuman, Charles	PHYSICS	Moved from Steering Committee Designee of the Committee on Environment, Quality of Life and Disability Issues to full member, assuming the spot vacated by Amy Bieber, who is out on leave. This creates a vacancy in the Steering Committee Designee position for this committee.	
Urciuoli, Jannette	COUNSELING	Removed from Committee on Committees, creating a vacancy. It was pointed out by a member of the Academic Senate that Prof. Urciuoli cannot resume her term on the Committee on Committees because it is still being served by Antonella Ansani. Although Dr. Ansani was elected to a new term of her own in May 2006, she was ineligible to run according to the Bylaws. ¹ After consulting with the Steering Committee, it has been determined that the person who fills this Committee on Committees vacancy must be elected by the Academic Senate.
