V. Recommendations

- Online Voting Proceedure: This procedure worked very well. I recommend that CoC Guide be revised
 to document the procedure that was followed in this first year of using an online voting interface
 (instead of Scantron ballots). I regret that I did not get to this update myself before the end of my
 tenure and I remain available to assist the current committee members in this task.
- Outgoing CoC Members: In the event that an outgoing CoC member is being considered for a position
 on one of the following year's Standing Committees of the Academic Senate, I recommend that he be
 required to recuse himself from any decisions the CoC makes relating to him.

VI. Outgoing Members

The chair wishes to thank Lorena Ellis and Laura Freedgood for their dedicated service to the Committee on Committees. As the third member whose term is expiring, the chair would like to thank the other members for making the past year a positive and productive one for the committee. The terms of Cesarano, Ellis and Freedgood expired with the election of three new members of the Committee on Committees in May. The chair would also like to thank Jacob Appleman for his service to the Committee until going on Travia leave during 2007-08. This was the first year of his three-year CoC term. From the time Professor Appleman went on Travia leave until the end of the 2007-08 academic year, his spot on the CoC remained vacant and the committee operated with 8 members instead of the usual 9. In May 2008, Sheila Beck was appointed to fill this vacancy.

Immediately following the May 2008 meeting of the Academic Senate, newly elected members Eugene Harris, (Biology & Geology), Phyllis Pace (Business) and Regina Rochford (Basic Skills) were introduced and Jannette Urciuoli was unanimously elected Chairperson for 2008-09 and Carol Soto was elected as Secretary.
