THE 2014 WOMEN'S FORUM EDUCATION AWARD INFORMATION SHEET

Women's Forum Inc. is a community where preeminent New York women leaders of diverse achievement come together to make a difference for each other and take an active leadership role in matters of importance to them. Since 1987 the Women's Forum Education Fund has provided Awards to help mature women—35 and older—pursue educational goals and enhance their capacities to provide leadership and productive and supportive service to their communities and beyond. The Award recognizes extraordinary and often heroic effort in overcoming adversity and the most daunting of odds in restructuring lives for success. Unlike scholarships and financial aid which are based primarily on need and academic performance, the Award recognizes women who already make a difference and whose record even as they overcome obstacles in their lives and their pursuit of higher education holds promise of even greater leadership.

Candidates for an Award and their references should share the narrative of obstacles confronted and overcome and also of demonstrated leadership and care for their community.

Eligibility:

The awards (\$10,000 each) will be given to women over the age of 35 who have faced and overcome adversity and now, after an interruption in their education, have resumed the pursuit of <u>their first Associate or Bachelor</u> degree. Applicants must demonstrate noteworthy promise and resilience in the face of challenges. Applicants must also demonstrate a commitment to helping others and to making a difference in their community, large or small, when their own career goals are achieved. Financial need is not the primary determining factor in the selection of recipients, although true financial need should be in evidence.

Applicant must:

- <u>be 35 years old</u> by December 1, 2013 (birth date no later than December 1, 1978)
- <u>reside</u> in New York City
- <u>be pursuing her FIRST Associate or Bachelor Degree, have earned at least 12 credits in</u> <u>good standing</u>
- <u>have attended</u> a college in New York City during the 2012-2013 academic year and <u>be</u> <u>enrolled for at least 6 credits</u> in the 2013-2014 academic year
- have at least 6 credits to complete graduation requirements after June 2014
- If completing an Associate degree, provide evidence of intention to continue to a Bachelor degree program.
- <u>Awardee</u> must complete her second semester <u>within twelve months of receiving the</u> <u>Award</u>, i.e., by July, 2015.

Applicant must submit an official transcript with her application. Candidates may be required to submit a second official transcript for spring semester 2014. Award will be given to the 2014 Women's Forum Awardees in two installments: \$5,000 upon notification of Award by June 30, 2014 and \$5,000 in January 2015 or July 2015, upon successful completion of an additional semester with 3 or more credits. Recipients will be required to submit an official transcript for their additional semester of 3 or more credits before the second installment will be

awarded. Students completing an Associate degree must also provide evidence of their intention to continue to a higher degree, and, if selected, provide evidence of admission to a Bachelor degree program. The Women's Forum will issue a Form 1099 to all Awardees in January 2015, for CY2014, and again in January 2016, for CY2015.

Applicant must submit **two Personal Essays** of no more than 500 words each, one addressing her personal history and one addressing her career goals and motivation. Both topics are described below:

- 1. Personal history, challenges, obstacles, other than financial, that she has overcome while pursuing an education, and general academic record as an indication of noteworthy leadership promise. (Financial need will be addressed separately.)
- 2. Career goals and motivation. If appropriate, include any meaningful involvement, as well as any leadership experience, in community service, art, athletics, business, science, or other extracurricular activities.

Applicant must also submit a separate brief **Financial Statement** describing her present and anticipated financial situation. Please state how receiving this Award will help and how applicant would wish to use the funds from the Award.

DEADLINE: APPLICATION, TRANSCRIPT AND LETTERS OF REFERENCE MUST BE POSTMARKED BY DECEMBER 1, 2013

- <u>Application</u> can be accessed and submitted on line at <u>www.womensforumny.org</u> or mailed to the Women's Forum and postmarked by December 1, 2013.
- <u>Official transcript</u> must be mailed to the Women's Forum and postmarked by December 1, 2013. An official transcript contains a college seal from the registrar.
- Letters of reference must be mailed to the Women's Forum and postmarked by December 1, 2013. They should be mailed in sealed envelopes that have been signed on the back by the endorsers. They may be mailed directly by the endorser or enclosed with the application, as long as the envelopes are sealed and signed on back by the endorsers.
- Application and confidential letters of reference <u>will not</u> be returned to the applicant.
- If mailing completed application, <u>do not staple</u> the application; Application should be single-sided.

- 2. Career goals and motivation. If appropriate, any meaningful involvement, as well as any leadership experience, in community service, art, athletics, business, science, or other extracurricular activities.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT

SUBMIT A SEPARATE FINANCIAL STATEMENT of no more than 100 words.

- Describe your present and anticipated financial situation. Please state how receiving this Award will help and how you would wish to use the funds from the Award.
- Financial need, as well as challenges surmounted and leadership potential, are considered by the Women's Forum Education Fund Award Committee.
- The Education Fund of the Women's Forum is required to issue a 1099 for each of the two installments of the award, one in 2014, and one in 2015.
