





Q5 If administrators are members, can they make motions?



Q6 Does the primary governance body membership include adjunct faculty?



Q7 Are members of the governance body elected?





Q9 Who presides?



Q10 Is the presiding officer elected by the body?



Q11 Does your primary governance body have authority to set college policy if not inconsistent with CUNY Board of Trustees Policy?



Q12 Other than the primary governance body, is there a separate faculty governance body?











Q17 If there is a college-wide Budget and Planning Committee, do the members include? (check all that apply.)







Q20 If there is a college-wide Budget and Planning Committee, does this committee advise the president on the College Budget and the Financial Plan before they are submitted?



Q21 If there is a college-wide Budget and Planning Committee, does this committee review actual expenditures and revenues?



Q22 If there is a college-wide Budget and Planning Committee, is this committee consulted when adjustments are needed to the budget or financial plan?



Q23 Is there a council or committee of academic department chairs separate from the Institution's Faculty Personnel Committee?





Q26 There is a faculty handbook? (please check all that apply)



Q27 There are published guidelines for reappointment, tenure and promotion of faculty?


