

SAMPLE CLUB CONSTITUTION

Article I. Name of QSA Student Club Article II. Purpose of Organization

Article III. Membership:

Include who is eligible for membership and how one may become a member.

Article IV. It Must Be Stated That:

No person shall be denied membership or office in this organization because of race, color, religious beliefs or non-belief, national origin, sex, political beliefs,

veteran, handicapped status, professional status or sexual orientation.

Article V. <u>It Must Be Stated That:</u>

Any action taken or situation created, intentionally, whether on or off premises, to produce mental or physical discomfort, embarrassment, harassment, or ridicule is prohibited. Such activities may include but are not limited to the following: use of alcohol; paddling in any form; creation of excessive fatigue; physical and psychological shocks; quests, treasure hunts, scavenger hunts, road trips or any other such activities carried on outside or inside of our campus; wearing of public apparel which is conspicuous and not normally in good taste; engaging in public stunts and buffoonery; morally degrading or humiliating games and activities;

and any other activities which are not consistent with Queensborough

Community College policies and regulations.

Article X. Conduct of Meetings:

Most meetings are conducted according to Robert's Rules of Order, although moderate rather than strict parliamentary procedures are normally followed.
